

REPORT OF THE SELF HELP INCORPORATED

During the program year ending September 30, 2007 Self Help, inc., received a total funding of approximately \$19M and provided direct services to 27,938 limited income houses in the area.

In the TOWN OF ABINGTON Self Help, Inc. provided services totaling \$315,830 to 555 households during program year 2007.

Self Help's total funding of \$19,059,457 does not tell the real value of services delivered to the area as a whole. This funding enabled us to mobilize an additional \$1,535,342 of other community resources such as, volunteers, donations of space, and private donations in the form of goods and services. Therefore, the total impact of Self Help, Inc., during the past program year was \$20,595,799.

In addition, Self Help currently employs 250 individuals. Many of these individuals are of limited income, and most reside in our service area.

We feel that October, 2006 through September 30, 2007 was a successful program year for us because we were able to assist as many individuals and/or families as we did, regardless of the challenges of being a human service provider.

We thank the Town of Abington and its representative to our board Ms. Lorraine Simon and Ms. Janet Johnson and all the volunteers for helping us to make fiscal year 2007 a successful one.
