

**WARRANT  
TOWN OF ABINGTON  
COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS  
SPECIAL TOWN MEETING**

Article 1: To see if the Town will vote to approve an increase in the amount of the demand fee placed on real estate, personal property, and motor vehicle bills from the current \$5.00 fee to an amount to be voted by Town meeting up to a maximum of \$30.00 in accordance with amended MGL Chapter 60, Section 15, or take any other action relative thereto.

***MOTION: The Finance Committee moves that the Town approve an increase in the amount of the demand fee placed on real estate, personal property, and motor vehicle bills from the current \$5.00 fee to an amount to be voted by Town meeting up to a maximum of \$30.00 in accordance with amended MGL Chapter 60, Section 15.***

Article 2: To see if the Town will vote to reduce the appropriation made by the vote under Article 26 of the April 9, 2008 Annual Town Meeting from \$2,045,000.00 to \$2,000,000.00 for the construction of Residual Handling Facilities at the Hannigan, Great Sandy Bottom and Myers Avenue Water Treatment Plants, including without limitation all costs incidental and related thereto, and to take any other action relative thereto?

***MOTION: The Finance Committee moves that the Town approves to reduce the appropriation made by the vote on Article 26 of the April 9, 2008 Annual Town Meeting from \$2,045,000.00 to \$2,000,000.00 .***

Article 3 : To see if the Town will vote to authorize the South Shore Regional School District to incur debt in the amount of Three Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,300,000.00) for a Roof and Window project, 52% of which is to be funded by the Massachusetts School Building Authority, or take any other action relative thereto.

***MOTION: The Finance Committee moves that the Town passover and not authorize the South Shore Regional School District to incur debt in the amount of Three Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollar Roof and Window project, 52% to be funded by the Massachusetts School Building Authority.***
